



- **REASONABLE EXPECTATION OF PRIVACY? WHAT IS IT FOR THE POLICE AND HOW TO APPLY IT?**
- **RETENTION IS TWO YEARS FOR ARRESTS AND/OR DETENTIONS. EXCEPTION IS MINOR TRAFFIC OFFENSES OR BUSINESS OFFENSES BY STATUTE.**
- **MINIMUM FOR ALL RECORDS IS NO LESS THAN NINETY DAYS. IF NOT FLAGGED MUST BE DESTROYED AFTER.**
- **EXTENSIVE DATA RETENTION AND DISTRIBUTION OF FOOTAGE INVOLVING INCIDENTS.**



- **QUICK DECISIONS BY OFFICERS DOES NOT REQUIRE A FAST RESPONSE IN REPORTS OR STATEMENTS WHEN VIDEO IS INVOLVED.**
- **ALLOW OFFICERS TO REVIEW FOOTAGE – USE OF FORCE (BODY & CAR CAMERAS)**
- **TIMELY RESPONSE TO THE PUBLIC & MEDIA ON SUBSTANCE OF INVESTIGATION**
- **DISCLOSURE ISSUES BASED ON BRADY v. MARYLAND – STATE’S ATTORNEY**
